The Christian understanding of hope illustrates how trivial our everyday use of the word can be. Hope generates energy and sustains people through difficult times. For some people, hope is so strong that it inspires self-sacrifice to turn hope into reality.

True hope is much more than a general idea that things will get better. It is more than a belief in progress, which sees the world and people as getting better all the time, growing away from violence, ignorance and confusion. Christian hope is grounded in the character of God.

Christian hope means trusting in the loving purposes of God: trusting that the foundations of the world are good because they spring from God. Hope is not always spontaneous or easy. There is work to be done. As well as trusting God, we have to develop qualities of steadfastness in our own character.
