Literacy links	<p>Reading Superworm Reading Super Ted Writing a short narrative about their own superhero adventure</p> <p>Word Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words <p>Reading Comprehension</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • becoming very familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics • Recognising and joining in with predictable phrase <p>Writing transcription</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spell common exception words • apply simple spelling rules and guidance, as listed in <u>English Appendix 1</u> <p>Handwriting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sit correctly at a table, holding a pencil comfortably and correctly • begin to form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place • form capital letters • form digits 0-9 • understand which letters belong to which handwriting 'families' (ie letters that are formed in similar ways) and to practise these <p>Composition</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • saying out loud what they are going to write about • composing a sentence orally before writing it <p>Vocabulary, Punctuation and Grammar</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • leaving spaces between words • joining words and joining clauses using "and" • beginning to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark
Maths links	<p>Number and Place Value-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number • Count read and write numbers to 100 in numerals • Given a number identify one more or one less

History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To learn about significant historical events, people and places in their own locality. (Richard Trevithick, Henry Trengrose)
Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use ariel photo's and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features: devise simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key. Children will be flying over looking down identifying key features like a superhero flying across the sky. (Ariel photo's)
DT	<p>Make</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select from and use a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks (for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing) Select from and use a wide range of materials and components including construction materials, textiles and ingredients according to their characteristics. To use a range of materials to make a superhero mask- Paper mache masks 3D/2D shapes. Junk modelling their own superhero.
