Golden tickets (each ticket is worth 1 house point)




Stickers, including headteacher stickers

# CONSEQUENCES

(Time-In strategy)



To escort or remove the child/ren to another part of the playground or field  
(New Face, New Place strategy)



To give the child a task or responsibility to do or send them somewhere where they can do this  
(Keep Busy strategy)



Adult may report the child/ren to the class teacher which may result in the child/ren:

Being moved down the Class Behaviour Board



- Missing class treat or Golden Time



Having to stay inside for a break time(s)
