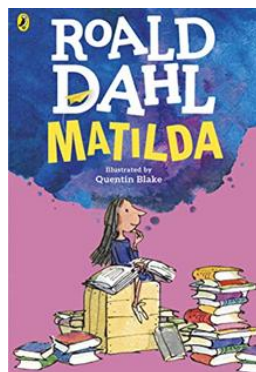

Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants:

- Identify and label parts of a plant
- Make observations and offer explanations
- Use a Venn diagram to sort and classify seeds in different ways.
- Identify a range of plant seeds using my observations.
- Make basic predictions and explain my reasons
- Carry out simple tests

#### What is the Good News that Jesus brings?

- Tell stories from the Bible and recognise a link with a concept of 'Gospel' or good news.
- Give clear, simple accounts of what Bible mean to Christians.
- Recognise that Jesus gives instructions to people about how to behave.
- Give examples of ways in which Christians follow the teachings studied about forgiveness and peace, and bringing good news to the friendless.
- Give examples of how Christians put these beliefs into practice.
- Think, talk and ask questions about whether Jesus' 'good news' is only good news for Christians, or if there are things for anyone to learn, exploring different ideas.
