Enrichment Activity	A trip to Shelterbox
Literacy links	Biographies, letters, newspapers, job applications.

Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object.</li> <li>Identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces.</li> </ul>

Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on Europe and North and South America and concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics, countries, and major cities.</li> <li>Identify the position and significance of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern hemisphere, Southern hemisphere, the tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, Arctic and Antarctic circle, the Prime/Greenwich meridian and time zones (including day and night)</li> <li>Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied. (Glacial Mountains)</li> </ul>

Art & Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials</li> </ul>
Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory</li> <li>Use and understand staff and other musical notations.</li> </ul>
Computing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use advanced search functions in Google.</li> <li>Understand websites such as Wikipedia are made by users.</li> <li>Use strategies to check the reliability of information e.g. cross-checking with books.</li> <li>Use their knowledge of domain names to aid their judgement of the validity of websites.</li> </ul>
